Sayın Akdeniz Kimyevi Maddeler ve Mamulleri İhracatçıları Birliği Üyemiz,

T.C. Ticaret Bakanlığı İhracat Genel Müdürlüğü'nden alınan yazıda; Pakistan Ulusal Tarife Komisyonu (Komisyon) tarafından ülkemiz menşeli "Soda Külü" (2836.20 Gümrük Tarife Pozisyonunda yer alan) ithalatına karşı bir anti-damping soruşturması başlatılmış olup, söz konusu sorusturmanın baslatıldığına dair 30 Mart 2021 tarihli bildirim ekte ver almaktadır.

Bu itibarla, söz konusu bildirimde, soruşturmaya taraf olmak isteyenlerin taleplerini soruşturma açılış bildiriminin yayımlanmasından itibaren 10 takvim günü içinde, soruşturmaya ilişkin hazırlayacakları bilgi ve belgeleri ise açılış bildiriminin yayımlanmasından itibaren 45 takvim günü içinde soruşturma otoritesine sunmaları gerekmektedir. Öte yandan, soruşturma kapsamında yayımlanan "Soru Formu" ve "Şikâyetin Gizli Olmayan Kopyası" Komisyon'dan temin edilmesini müteakip Birliklerine iletilecektir.

Bununla birlikte, Bakanlığımızın "Ticaret Politikası Savunma Araçları" internet adresinde (<u>www.tpsa.gov.tr</u>) "Türk İhraç Ürünlerine Yönelik Uygulanan Ticaret Politikası Savunma Önlemleri" başlığı altında yer alan Türkiye İhracatçılar Meclisi (TİM) tarafından düzenlenen "Ticaret Politikası Önlemleri Soruşturmaları ve Genelleştirilmiş Tercihler Sistemi Uygulamaları Kapsamında Firmalarca Alınacak Avukatlık ve/veya Danışmanlık Hizmeti Harcamalarının Desteklenmesine İlişkin Uygulama Usul ve Esasları"nın (Usul Esaslar) incelenmesinde fayda görülmektedir.

Notice of Initiation of Anti-Dumping Investigation on Alleged Dumped Imports of Disodium Carbonate (Soda Ash) into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the Republic of Turkey

National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") has received an application on February 16, 2021 under Section 20 of Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the "Act") from M/s. ICI Pakistan Limited, Lahore and M/s. Olympia Chemical Limited, Lahore (the "Applicants"). The Applicants are producer of Disodium Carbonate, popularly known as "Soda Ash". The Applicants have alleged that Soda Ash is being exported to Pakistan at dumped prices from Republic of Turkey ("Turkey"), which has caused and are causing injury to the domestic industry producing domestic like product.

Upon initial examination and assessing accuracy and adequacy of the evidence and information provided in application in accordance with Section 23 of the Act, the Commission is satisfied that the evidence and information provided in the application is sufficient to justify initiation of an investigation into the matter.

Initiation of Investigation: The Commission hereby initiates an investigation pursuant to Section 23 of the Act. The investigation will determine whether Soda Ash originating in and/or exported from Turkey is dumped into Pakistan and whether such dumping has caused and /or is causing injury to the domestic industry within the meaning of provisions of the Act. The Commission, during the course of this investigation, will call further information/data from the interested parties deemed necessary for the purposes of this investigation.

Product under Investigation: The product allegedly being dumped into Pakistan is Disodium Carbonate, popularly known as Soda Ash, having chemical formula Na₂CO₃, imported from Turkey (the "investigated product"). Soda Ash is a white, crystalline, water-soluble material. The investigated product falls under HS/ Pakistan Customs Tariff ("PCT") No. 2836.2000. The investigated product is used in the manufacture of detergents, soaps, cleaning compounds, sodium based chemicals, float glass, container, tableware and specialty glasses, silicates and other industrial chemicals. It is also widely used in paper, metallurgical industries and desalination plants.

Period of Investigation (POI): For determination of dumping and injury, the POI is as follows:

All written submissions provided by interested parties on a confidential basis must be marked "Confidential" and in accordance with Section 31 of the Act, shall be accompanied by a non-confidential version/summary, which will be placed in the public file.
